Journeying Home: Yearning for a Sure Object of our Hope Psalm 130

The Question: When in the depths of conviction for sin, where can we find hope? **I. The Plea** - of the Penitent: **Have Mercy** (1-2)

II. The Provision - of our Awesome God: Forgiveness (3-4)

III. The Posture - of a Believer: Waiting (5-6)

IV. The Proclamation - of the Psalmist: Put your Hope in the Lord (7-8)

Point to Ponder: Paul wrote: "In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, in accordance with the riches of God's grace that he lavished on us with all wisdom and understanding." (Eph. 1:7-8) Have you known this full redemption? Have you experienced the forgiveness of sins that Jesus won through his blood? If so, then how has our proclamation been like that of the psalmist - calling others to hope in the Lord - for in Him alone can be found full redemption for all our sins?
