

Journeying Home: Looking for Security Psalm 125

Question: Can real security be found in a world that is a cauldron full of reasons for insecurity?
I. Security - Made Certain (vs. 1-3)
A. In the Lord, believers are as secure as the mountains (1-2)
B. Their faith will survive even the rule of wicked people (3)
II. Security - Sought from God (vs. 4)

III. Security - Missed by Some (vs. 5)

Point to Ponder: Take time to read Revelation 20:11-21:5. In this passage we see the final judgment come. On the heels of hearing about the lot of those whose names were not written in the book of life, we hear something about the lot of those whose names are written in that book. The difference between these two lots could not be more stark - a "lake of fire" contrasted with those prepared "as a bride beautifully dressed for her husband." Security to the end is something to rejoice in now! (Phil. 1:6)
