Living into God's Story A Story of Reconciliation Genesis 45:1-28

Question: In this world, and in our life, does it seem at times, that the wrong seems oft so strong? If so, then what should we know about our God in these times?

I. The Big Reveal (1-3)

II. The Even Bigger Reveal (4-12)

"For the Son of Man goes as it has been determined, but woe to that man by whom he is betrayed" (Lk. 22:22)

III. Living into God's Bigger Story (13-28)

"For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life." (Jn3:16)

"In my father's house are many rooms... If I go to prepare a place for you, I will come again and take you to myself, that where I am you may be also." (Jn. 14:2-3)

Point to Ponder: "This is my Father's world / O let us not forget / That though the wrong seems oft so strong / God is the ruler yet." Have we forgotten that this is our Father's World, and that even in the face of evil, He is the ruler yet?
