The Lord Roars Let Justice Roll Down Amos 5:18-27

Questions: When is the last time you read a story with a great plot twist or surprise ending? Were the characters delighted at how things ended? Were they in shock? Would knowing the ending have changed the courses of the character's stories?

- 1. An unexpected ending (18-20)
- 2. A impassioned rejection (21-23)
- 3. A indispensable essential (24)
- 4. A prophetic reminiscence (25)
- 5. A dreadful destination (26-27)

Points to ponder: God, out of a deep steadfast love, pleads with his people to change direction as their present course leads to destruction. What would a life of repentance and faith look like in the days of Amos? How would God assess our own course of life... and our ultimate destination? What does Amos's call teach us about the nature of genuine faith?
