Rightly Handling the Word of Truth
2 Timothy 2:14-19

Question: how do we keep a healthy church healthy?

I. How God's People Should Avoid (14a, 15)

II. What God's People Should Avoid (14b, 16-18)

"But avoid foolish controversies, genealogies, dissensions, and quarrels about the law, for they are unprofitable and worthless (Titus 3:9)."

III. How God's People Can Stand (19)

~Jn. 10:14,27-30 – He knows us and we are safe in His hands (He preserves)
~Heb. 10:35-39 – we are called to persevere (we persevere)

Points to Ponder: What influence do my words have on others within this fellowship? (Does it have value to others, or does it tend to produce quarrels or ungodliness in others?) Would I be ashamed if God examined how I handle his Word?
