Points to Ponder:

- When is the last time you had a deep sense of the riches of God's love for you? Do you believe you are deeply and personally loved by God through Jesus?
- How do you rehearse the story of the Jesus's sacrificial actions in your life? How does this story compete with other stories we tell about ourselves?
- Why is it critical that we know that we were poor, but that now we are now rich? Why does Paul desire the Corinthians to know and be reminded that they are rich?
- Paul calls the Corinthians to rehearse their involvement in the gospel story so that they might be like Jesus and love tangibly. How does the gospel story motivate you to love sacrificially?
- Where is God calling you to follow Jesus and take action with same gospel love to others?
