Come Thou Long Expected Jesus Waiting with Ezekiel Ezekiel 34:11-16

Question: For what, or for whom, are we waiting in this life that regularly disappoints us?

I. Gathering the Sheep (vs. 11-13)

"For the Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost." Lk. 19:10

II. Caring for the Sheep (vs. 14-16)

"The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy. I came that they may have life and have it abundantly. I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep." Jn. 10:10-11.

Point to Ponder: Do you feel like you are a sheep that's wandering and lost at night? Then, could it be, that today is the day you are found by the Good Shepherd?
