Guarding the Good Deposit Becoming Useful to Our Lord 2 Timothy 2:20-26


Question: Useful to our Lord or not – which am I?

"Well done, good and faithful servant. You have been faithful over the little contents of your life; I will set you over much. Enter the joy of your master (Matthew 25:23b)

- I. Which One Am I: Useful or not? (vs. 20-21)
- II. How Do I become Useful to our Lord (22)
- III. What Does Being Useful Look Like? (23-26)

Points to Ponder: Paul insists that if Timothy's life was to be useful to our Master, then he must be fleeing from some things, and pursuing others "with those who call on the name of the Lord." How much are we doing life with those who call on the name of the Lord? To whom can we turn for help in running rightly the race set out before us?

Next Week: next Sunday we will continue our sermon series *Guarding the Good Deposit* by considering **2 Timothy 3:1-9**, "Look Out for False Teachers."
